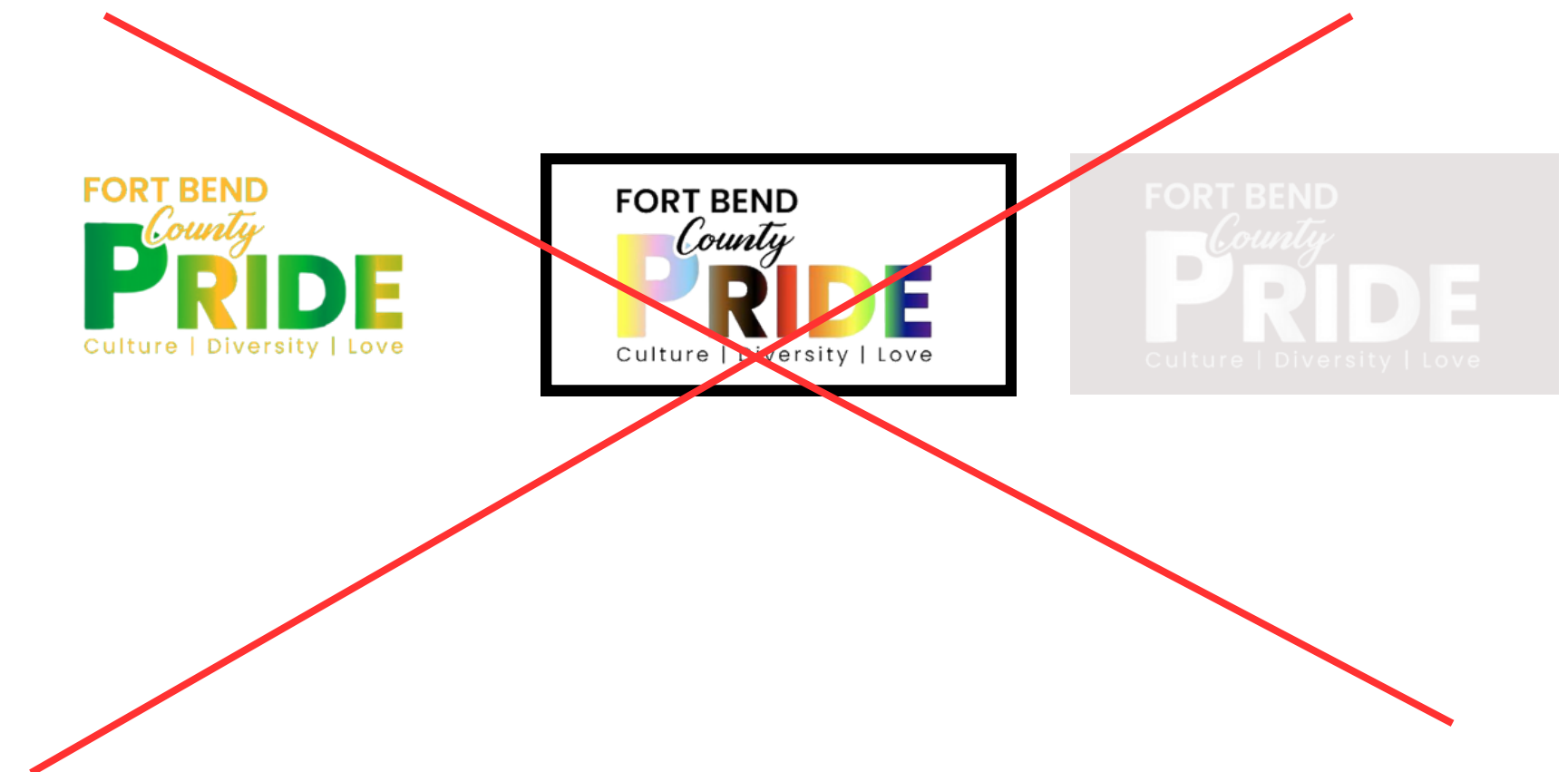
Versions & Background
